Title: Resolution to Stop Lawsuit by Washington AG Against Health-Care Measure

WHEREAS the people of the State of Washington have clearly and unequivocally demonstrated their support for health-care reform, and

WHEREAS the Attorney General of the State of Washington, Rob McKenna, has announced his intention to join Washington to a lawsuit against the recently-passed Federal health-care measure, the "Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act" (HR3590), and

WHEREAS such action represents neither the will nor the interests of the people of the State of Washington,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the King County Democrats call upon our state legislators in the House and the Senate to take immediate action to terminate state funding for the above-mentioned lawsuit, and take other action(s) which they deem appropriate to require AG McKenna to cancel participation by the State of Washington in the lawsuit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we call upon the Governor to censure the AG for his misfeasance, and admonish him to adhere to his Oath of Office and Duties as specified in the Constitution of the State of Washington.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be transmitted to the Governor, and to each state legislator whose district is fully or partially within the borders of King County.
