

# 30 Legislative District Reorganization Meeting

January 2, 2019

## Proposed Rules

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1. Sign-in is required at check-in.
2. Eligible voters shall be limited to PCOs elected during the August 7, 2018 Primary (including any PCOs who were elected without appearing on a ballot because they were the only person to file in their precincts) unless otherwise noted. Proxies shall not be recognized in any voting.
  - A. Eligible voters will be issued credentials
  - B. A simple majority, i.e. more than 50%, vote of members present and voting is necessary to approve any vote unless otherwise noted
3. The meeting shall be called to order by the Temporary Chair.
  - A. The Temporary Chair shall preside until the election of the new Chair
  - B. The Temporary Chair shall appoint a temporary secretary, parliamentarian, and tally committee chair
4. The Temporary Chair shall review the Proposed Rules with the Body.
5. The Body shall vote to approve the meeting Rules.
6. Election of officers shall proceed in the following order:
  - A. Chair
  - B. 1st Vice Chair
  - C. 2nd Vice Chair  
*Both King and Pierce Counties must be represented among the offices of Chair, 1st Vice-Chair, and 2nd Vice-Chair.*
  - D. State Committee Representative (2 of distinct gender)
  - E. KCDCC Representative (2 of distinct gender)
  - F. KCDCC Alternate (2 of distinct gender)
  - G. PCDCC Executive Board Representative (3, gender balanced where practical)
  - H. Endorsements Chair
  - I. Legislative Action Committee Representative
  - J. Legislative Action Committee Alternate
  - K. Young Democrats Representative(s)  
*One representative from each Washington Young Democrats, King County Young Democrats and Pierce County Young Democrats may be selected*
  - L. Treasurer (**all member vote**)
  - M. Deputy Treasurer (**all member vote**)
  - N. Secretary (**all member vote**)

7. Process for nominating and electing all positions shall include the following:
  - A. Call for nominations  
*Nominations must be accepted in person or in writing*
  - B. Close nominations
  - C. Five minutes total for each candidate to present and/or have other members present on their behalf
    - i. Order of presentations determined by order of nominations.
  
8. Ballot Procedures:
  - A. For contested positions, voting will be by signed ballot
  - B. Uncontested positions shall not require a written ballot
  - C. If no person receives a majority on the first ballot cast, the person receiving the least votes, and any other person who wishes to resign his or her nomination, shall be eliminated. On each succeeding ballot, the same rule shall apply until one person receives a majority of votes cast for that position.
